- You are required to renew your membership each year with your **Home** Office.
- If you wish to establish a Service Office, you must apply to that office (and meet the requirements) at the beginning
 of each calendar year. To apply, please use a Service Office Request Form. A Service Office fee may be charged to
 maintain your file and ensure that you receive member mailings. You will be notified of this fee by the Service Office.
